## CMCA Board Meeting Agenda with Meeting Notes October 14, 2021

- Painting bid for the trim on the CM Community Center bid from Knock Out Painting \$3,700
  - Board approved and Anita confirmed there are enough funds in the School House/Community Center Preservation bucket.
- 9th Street Emergency Shed supplies budget.
  - Wendy will take the lead on getting all items/supplies needed to stock the shed (based on the inventory of the other two sheds). Board approved her to use up to \$4,000 of funds from the Emergency bucket and Anita confirmed the funds are available.
- Equipment for ZOOM Anessa has offered to continue to use her set up for Zoom in the near term. We need to consider a budget for an upgrade to the community center equipment to accommodate Zoom.
  - Annesa is ordering a longer microphone cord to help fix the sound issues from the last meeting. Board did not talk about the budget for future equipment, but Annesa agreed to set up/run Zoom and audio for the meetings for a while.
- CM Community Center Users request from community members to exclude political and religious organizations/activities
  - Board approved a refinement and restriction to be added to the Community Center rental agreement and rules. Verbiage to be provided by Wendy will be added to the Cape Meares website to state: Cannot be used for Political or Religious events.

  - The website has undergone some updates recently. The 'about' section and the 'event calendar' section. These updates will be a continued effort to get the entire website refreshed and current.
- Fundraising
