

## **CAPE MEARES COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION**

### **Emergency CMCA Board/Community Meeting**

**October 17, 2021**

CMCA Board members in attendance: Wendy Burroughs, Anita Johanson, Randy Klobas, Tome Deckard, Annesa Eastburn

Meeting called by CMCA President Wendy Burroughs, to address logging activity on the Grimm Property and potential impacts to the CMCA Property and the Cape Meares Community.

- It came to the attention of the Cape Meares Community that logging efforts had been started on the Grimm property (appx. 120 acres). Notably, silt flowing into Coleman Creek. Upon further research, a myriad of concerns were noted and sent to the CMCA board to immediately address.
- The major concerns:
  - Proposed logging project is immediately east and south of the Cape Meares neighborhood
  - Ground disturbance on steep slopes around Coleman Creek
  - Logging taking place in a slide zone
  - CMCA culvert
  - Water Tank
  - Work on Grimm property started prior to the permitted date
- Action taken by the board
  - Motion approved by CMCA Board members present, authorizing Wendy Burroughs to consult with an Attorney on behalf of the CMCA and allocated up to \$3,500 to retain the services of an Attorney.
